Crash Investigation

Aberdeen, MD – On Tuesday, October 5, 2021, at approximately 6:45 AM, officers responded to a motor vehicle crash involving a bicyclist on Aberdeen Thruway (SR22) just prior to Beards Hill Road. Upon arrival officers found 25-year-old Duncan Taylor of Aberdeen suffering from head trauma. Mr. Taylor was the operator of a bicycle. Emergency Medical Services from Aberdeen Fire Department responded and began treating Mr. Taylor for his injuries. Mr. Taylor was transported to a trauma center in Baltimore, Maryland. The operator of the vehicle was identified as 51-year-old Alan Ewing of Aberdeen. He was not injured in the crash. A Crash Reconstruction team was requested from the Harford County Sheriff's Office to respond and assist in the investigation.

The investigation into what occurred is ongoing and anyone who witnessed the crash is asked to contact the Harford County Traffic Unit, Deputy Jackson at 443-409-3533.
